

The Feast of the Resurrection of our Lord God and Savior, Jesus Christ

Divine Liturgy Propers, starting with Baptismal Hymn

Instead of “Holy God...” (page 31) we sing:

† All you, who have been baptized into Christ,* you have put on Christ! Alleluia!

Prokeimenon, Tone 8: (page 33)

This is the day which the Lord has made;* let us rejoice and be glad in it.

verse: Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good,* for His mercy endures forever.

Alleluia, Tone 4: (page 33)

verse: When You rise,* You will have compassion on Sion.

verse: The Lord looked down from heaven to earth to hear the groans of the prisoners,* to set free the sons of those put to death.

Hymn to the Mother of God: (page 57)

The Angel cried out to the One full of Grace:* O chaste Virgin, rejoice!* And again I say, Rejoice!* Your Son has risen from the tomb on the third day,* and raised the dead.* Let all people rejoice!* Shine, shine, O new Jerusalem!* for the glory of the Lord has risen upon you!* Exult now and be glad, O Sion!* And you, O chaste Mother of God, take delight* in the resurrection of your Son.

Communion verse: (page 67)

Receive the Body of Christ;* taste the fountain of immortality.* Alleluia, alleluia,* alleluia.

Paschal Troparion:

Christ is risen from the dead, trampling death by death, and to those in the tombs giving life.

Instead of *Blessed is He...* (page 71), we sing: Christ is risen...

Instead of *We have seen the true light...* (page 73) we sing: Christ is risen...

Instead of *May our mouths be filled...* (page 73) we sing: Christ is risen...**(3 X)**

Instead of *Blessed be the name of the Lord...* (page 77) we sing: Christ is risen...**(3 X)**

Instead of *Glory be to the Father...* (page 77) we sing in simple chant: Christ is risen...

After the final Amen, (page 79) the priest, with cross raised on high, exclaims:

Christ is risen (*thrice*) and faithful respond: Truly He is risen (*each time*).

Priest: sings the Paschal Troparion once.

Faithful: sing the Paschal Troparion once.

Priest: sings first half of the Paschal Troparion.

Faithful: conclude the Paschal Troparion.

Priest: And to us He granted life eternal;

Faithful: We bow down to His resurrection on the third day.
