Entrance: (page 29)

Troparion, Tone 4: (page 29)

Today is the crown of our salvation,* and the unfolding of the eternal mystery;* the Son of God becomes the Virgin's Son,* and Gabriel brings the good tidings of grace.* With him let us also cry to the Mother of God:* Rejoice, Full of grace! The Lord is with you.

Kontakion, Tone 8:

To You, O Mother of God,* the invincible leader,* we, your servants, ascribe these victory hymns* in thanksgiving for our deliverance from evil.* With your invincible power free us from all dangers* that we may cry out to you:* Hail, O Bride and pure Virgin!

Prokeimenon, Tone 4: (page 33)

Proclaim from day to day* the good tidings of our God's salvation.

verse: Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth.

Alleluia, Tone 1: (page 33)

verse: He will descend like rain on a fleece,* and like drops dripping on the earth.

verse: Let His name be blessed through the ages;* His name exists before the sun.

Hymn to the Mother of God: (page 57)

O earth, announce good news of great joy,* praise God's glory, O heavens.

Irmos, Tone 4:
